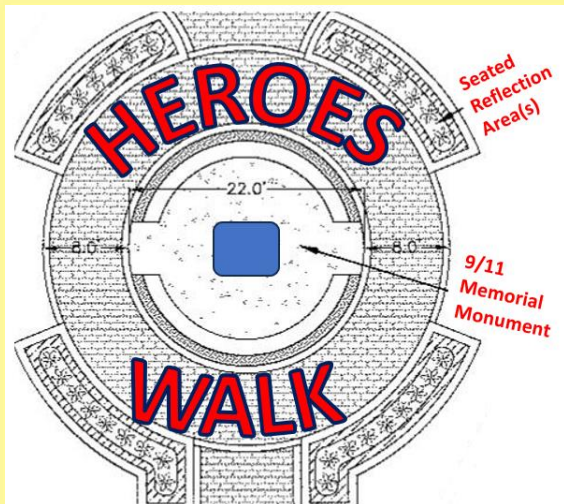

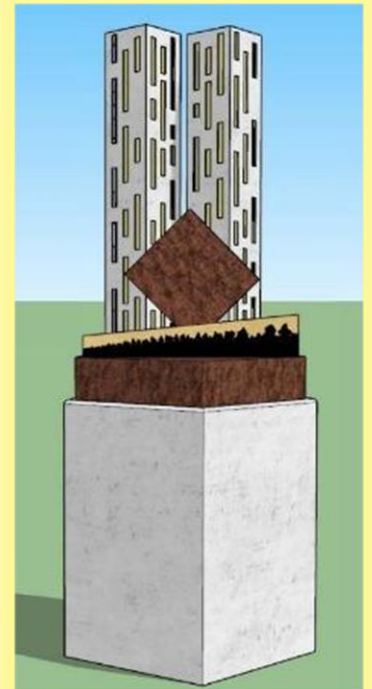
### HW Sponsorship Application Steps:

The **9/11 Memorial Monument** features a piece of steel from the Twin Towers. The Towers are supported by a Pentagon-shaped pier and the tree line in front of the steel represents Pennsylvania. The monument will be surrounded by a **Heroes Walk** to honor the brave souls who have and who continue to selflessly serve in military and first responder organizations.
